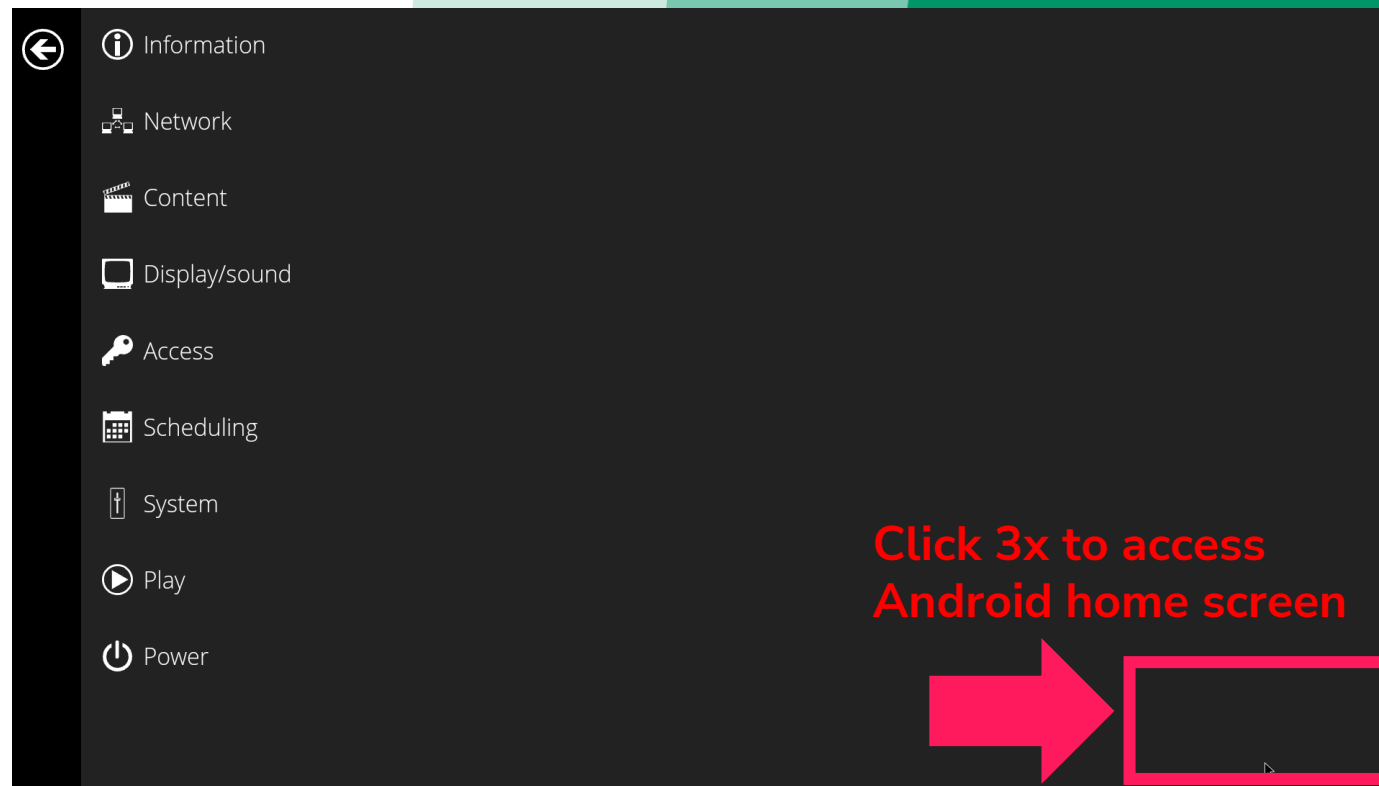


Preparation

- Prepare a USB drive or SD Card
- Copy the app onto a USB thumb drive or SD Card and insert it into IAdea device

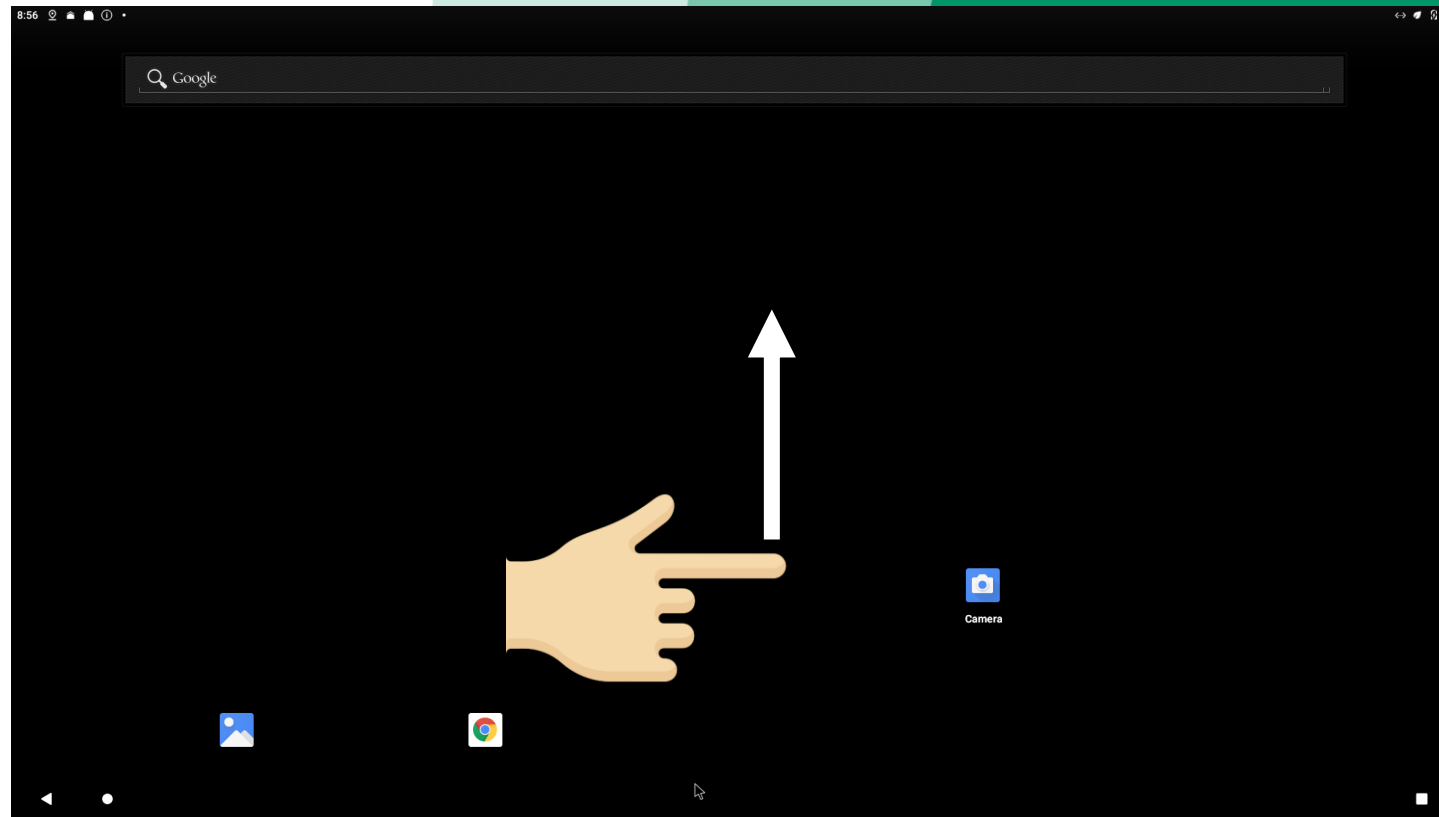
Enter Android System

- At Basic Settings, click “Advanced” to enter screen below, then click on the “lower right corner” 3 times using the mouse



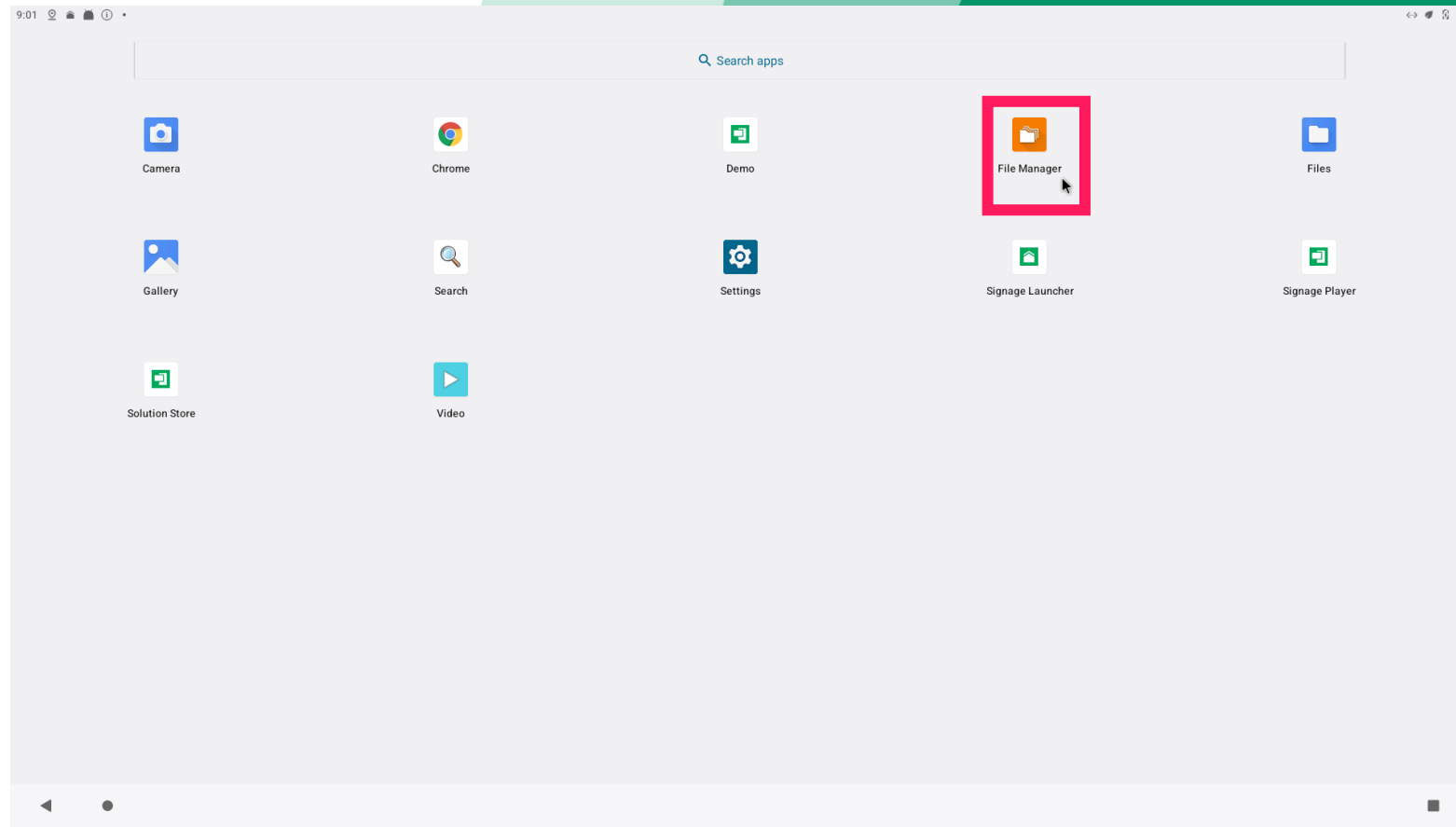
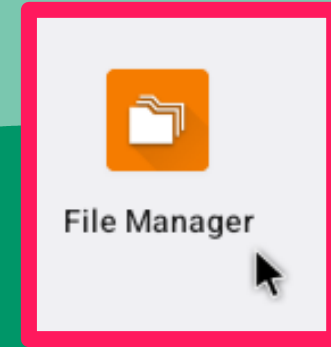
Enter Android Applications Page

- Scroll up from your Android home screen to access the applications page



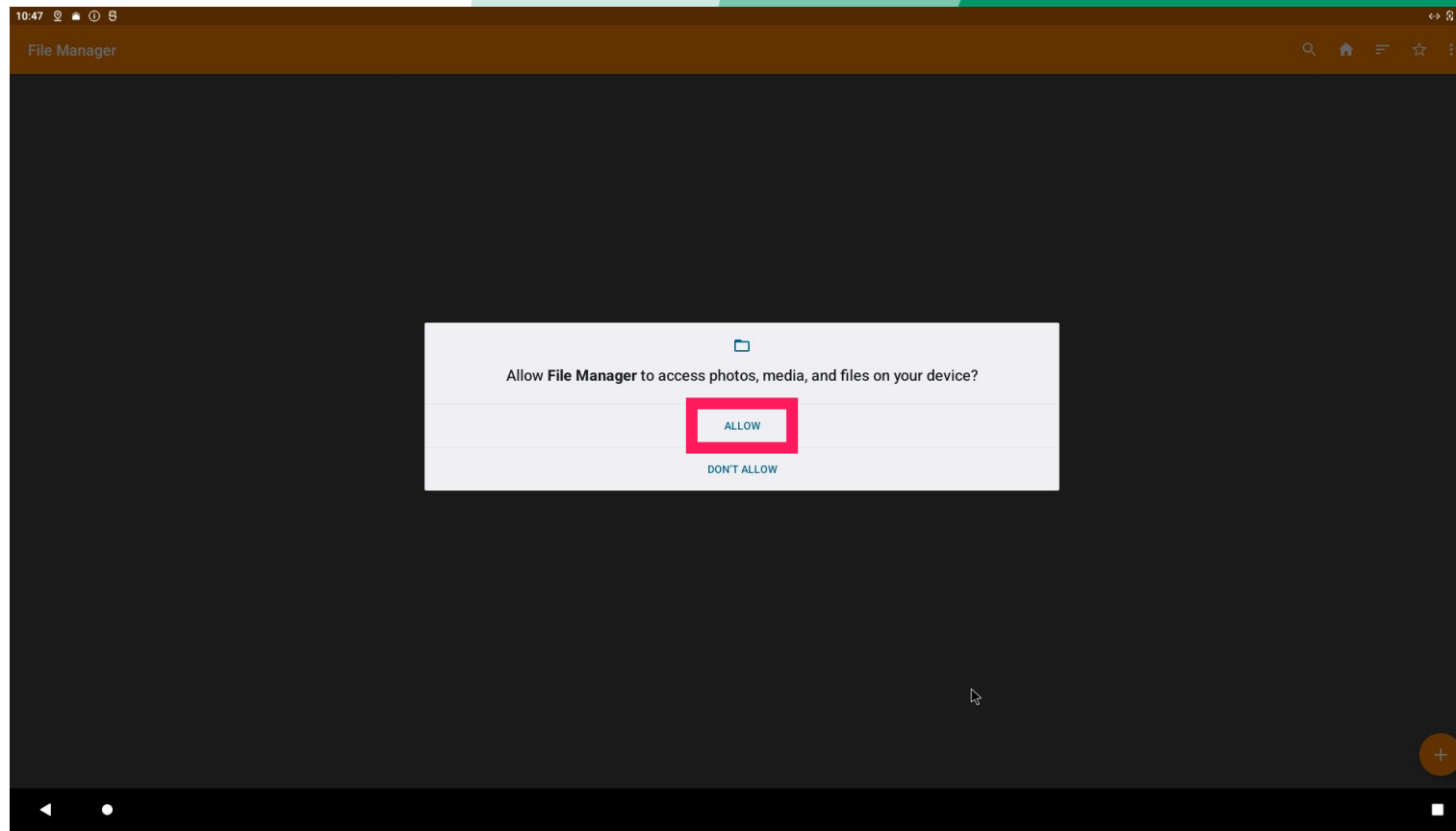
Enter File Manager

- Open the File Manager



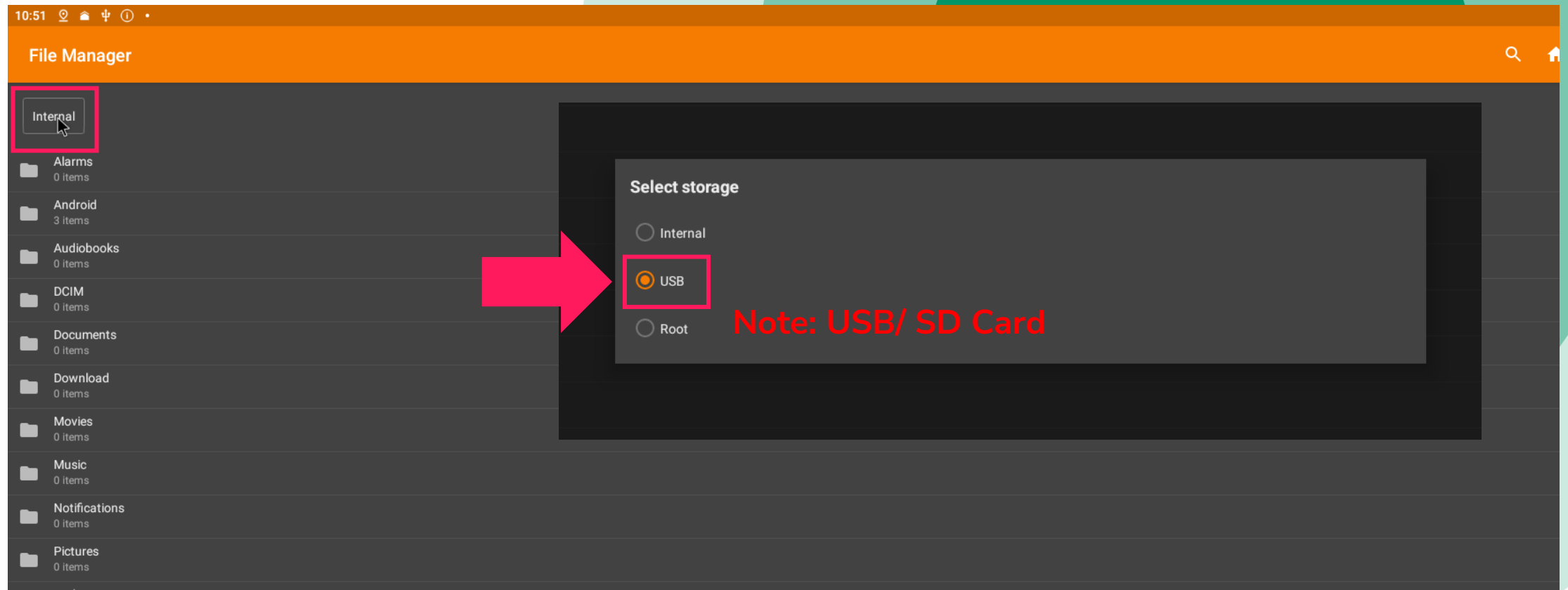
Allow Permissions

- If this is the first time you try to open the File Manager, this will pop up



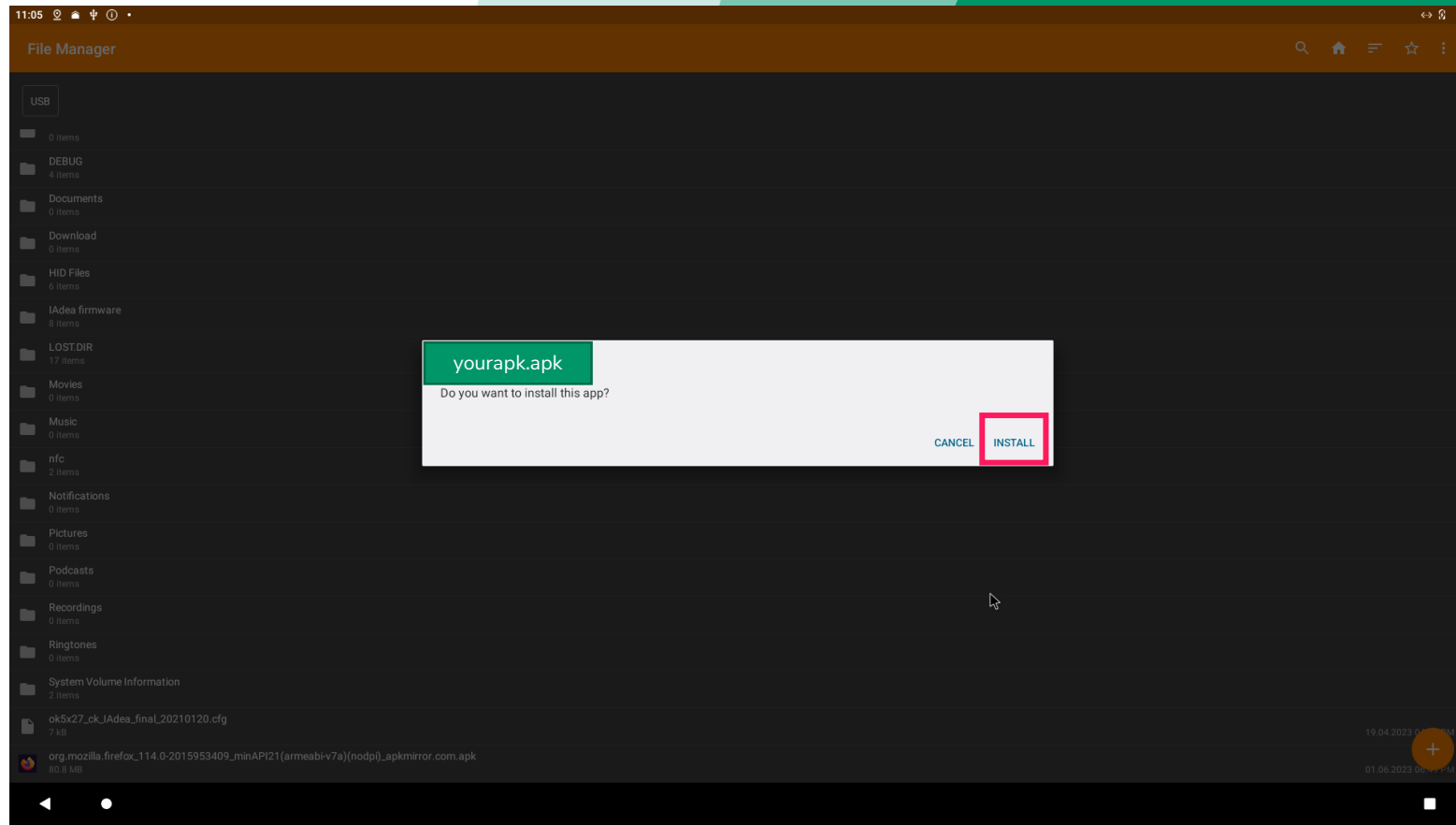
Enter External Device Folder

- Click icon to change the folder from 'Internal' to 'USB'



Install Your .apk

- Click the apk file you are going to install and click 'Install'



Grant Permission if Asked

- Click the apk file you are going to install and click 'Install'
