About iCalendar Widget

- ➤ What is iCalendar
 - It's an Internet calendar format
 - Supported by a large number of products, including Google Calendar, Apple Calendar, IBM Lotus Notes, Yahoo! Calendar, Mozilla Thunderbird and Microsoft Outlook....
- > Advantage of iCalendar Widget
 - Easy to manage. The player will automatically sync with the latest schedule and display event information accordingly

How it works (using Google Calendar + XDS-1062)

User loads iCalendar widget on player using MgrExp/SignApps/USB/WAN



Every time the user changes the calendar on Google Calendar





XDS-1062 automatically gets the schedule and updates the screen on time

In the Private Address section, right click on the "ICAL" button and copy the link


The link should point to a **basic.ics** file



FAQ

> Which firmware or software version should I use?

- XMP-6x00, XDS-107x
 - Firmware 1.2.11 or later
- SignApps Express
 - 2.2.40 or later
- XMP-2x00, XDS-106x, XDK-1x60
 - Firmware 4.4.181 or later
- Manager Express
 - 4.3.40 or later

> Do I need to enter the iCal-link in the option every time?

 No, you don't. After the player is set up for the first time, you will not need to enter the .ics link anymore. But if the player is reset to factory default or you would like to use a different calendar, you will need to enter the link again.

> Do you support any iCalendar other than Google's?

• Currently Google Calendar is officially supported, but please ask us if you need support for other options (Exchange Server, Outlook, etc.). If your calendar can be accessed from an iPhone, chances are it supports iCalendar and we should then be able to support it.

> Can I customize the calendar look? I think it can be made prettier.

Sure! Anyone with HTML5 webpage authoring skills can modify the iCalendar widget source code to add a company logo, change the color theme or show additional information from your calendar.
